## A. Goal Developments/Expectation.

- 5. The Admin team to foster Authentic Professional relations, openness within the chain of command.
- 6. Data Wall: Know how students are transitioning throughout the school year.

The board discussed cohesive decisions with the importance of cohesion among the administrative team. It is important to stick to talking points. The various entities need to share the same vision.

The board supports data drive decision. The assessment piece needs to be up front. Hard questions need to be asked at the start. The process needs to be followed towards the end process.

Solid education leaders are important. They must have the ability to build up the staff. They are part of the cohesive relationships that relates to data and a vision.

The board discussed strong professional relationships.

From the six topics of discussion, the board narrowed the items down to supporting cohesive decisions, data driven decisions, and a solid educational vision.
