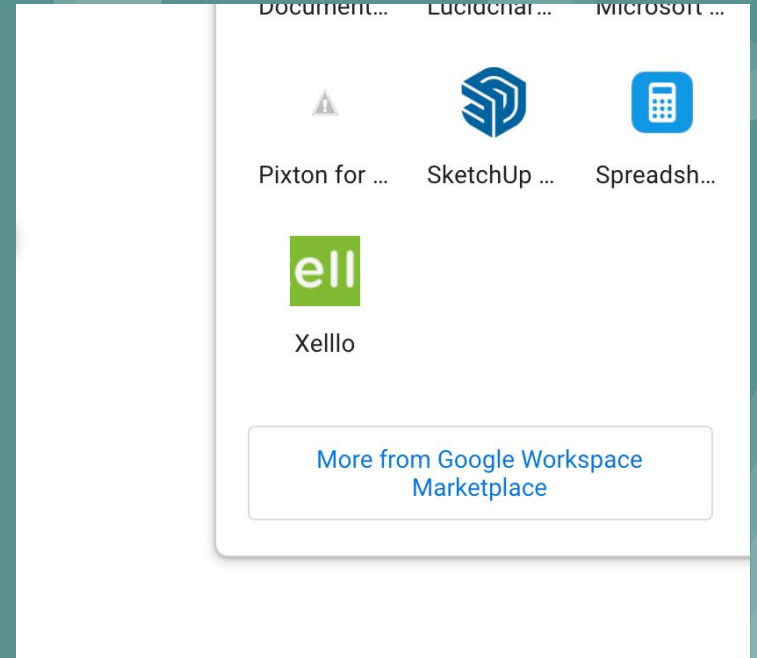

Logging into Xello

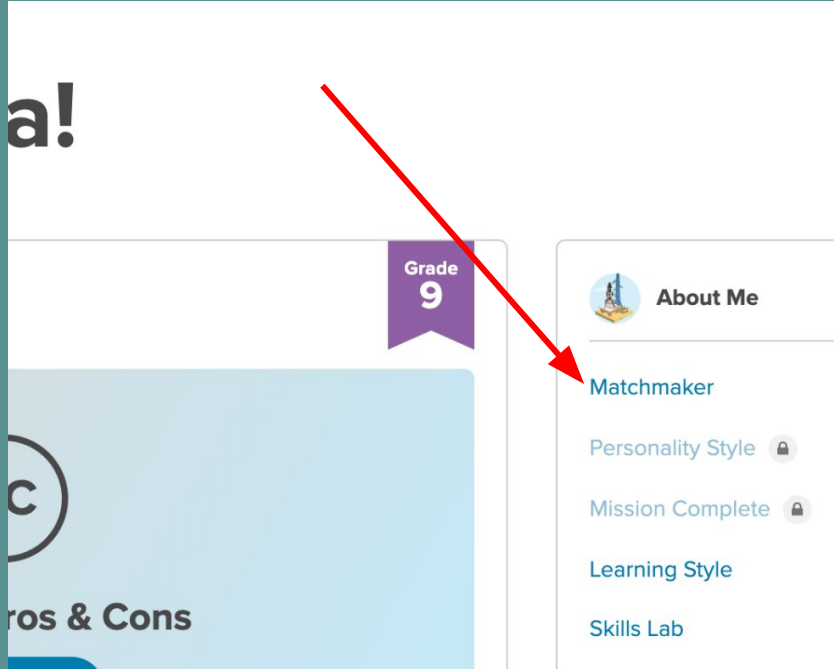
Navigate to the Google Apps to find the Xello Application. You are automatically logged into Xello as long as you are logged into Google.



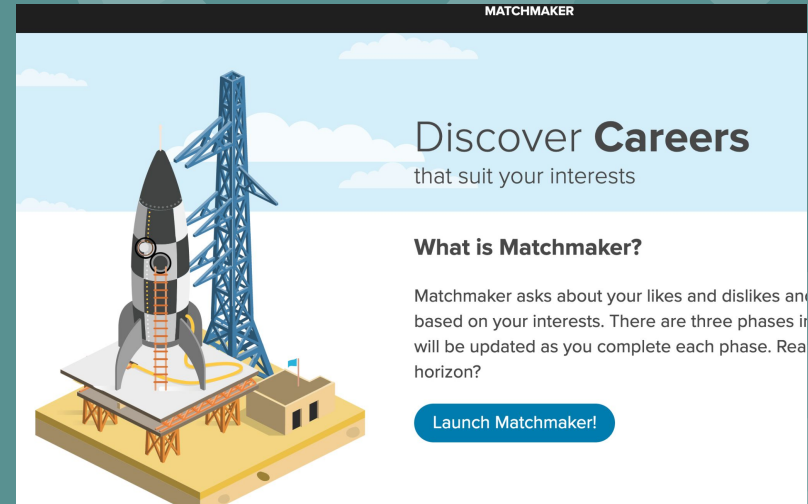
Once logged in, your page should look like this.

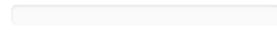


