Grade Level: 9th – 12th	
Recommended Sequence	Seminar Meeting
Objective(s) / Learning Target(s):	1. Students will be taking a survey to reflect upon how their emotions impact their learning and their behavior.
Materials Needed:	Materials 1. None – just student laptops
Suggested Process:	1. Before you start the activity, ask your students to share any pieces of good news they have (something good that’s happened to them since your last meeting – from school, personal lives, extra-curriculars, etc.). Not everyone has to share, but give kids a chance to do this. You can model this by sharing a piece of good news that you have. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How was Homecoming? • What did you like or not like about it? • If you could change one thing (take it out or add something new) what would it be? • What have you seen other schools do to celebrate Homecoming that you wished we did at GHS? 2. Next, have students take out their computers and do a quick grade check. If students are missing an assignment or are doing poorly in a class, have them email that particular teacher and ask that they be requested for MTSS on Friday. 3. Finally, tell students that they will be completing a survey that will help our school determine specific needs of students in a variety of areas. Here are the directions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Survey Link: https://forms.gle/eXeea9PuE3Z96ZKx9 * Send students the link via email * Once they open the survey, have remind them not to talk or discuss the items with each other; Be honest with your answers as they won’t be shared with anyone except their counselors * Once they are done, have them submit it and close their laptops and wait for their classmates to get done.
