Grinnell High School Laptop Roll-Out: August 24, 2016

PURPOSE: To inform students of the expectations, policies, protections, care & maintenance information, & security information that are outlined in the G-N Acceptable Use Agreement.

OVERVIEW OF ACCEPTABLE USE POLICIES:

- The machine is the property of the district
 - Intended for educational use, to support the learning environment
 - Usage is a privilege, not a right
 - The school retains the right to inspect, confiscate,
 & reimage the machine at any time for any reason
- Student expectations for use of the laptop:
 - Don't share your machine, parts/pieces, or passwords
 - Should be in your possession or secured (on you, in your locker, at home; NOT in your car, NOT at your friend's house, NOT laying around the school, locker rooms, or cafeteria)
 - Bring it to school charged & ready each day

OVERVIEW OF ACCEPTABLE USE POLICIES:

- Student expectations for use of the laptop:
 - Save & back up your work
 - "Loaner Laptops" need to be checked in to the Media Center at the end of the day
 - DON'T use the laptop to harass others
 - DON'T use the laptop to illegally download materials or programs
- Student care and maintenance of the laptop:
 - Carrying case; Don't deface the machine; Keep them on a flat surface; Don't use them @ lunch or around food & drinks; BOTTOM LINE: Treat this as if it were your own

- Student care and maintenance of the laptop:

- Wind your cord carefully; Wait until your power light is pulsing before you put it away; Don't remove the ID tags on your machine; BOTTOM LINE: *Treat this as if it were your own*

Consequences for misuse:

- Confiscation of the machine
- Internet/networking capabilities deactivated
- Reimaging of the machine
- Detention, suspension, expulsion
- Civil or criminal liability under applicable laws
- Damage fee schedule: 1st incident \$100; 2nd incident \$200, 3rd incident full cost of repair
 - You could be charged for the full cost of the machine if the damaged is caused by gross negligence
 - If you ruin your charger, we will have replacements available at a cost of \$65.00 (paid by you)

HMS GAGGLE

- Yes, your email is read by other humans . . .
- Email, Chat, & Internet filter that notifies the student & administration if the content is inappropriate
- Reasons include:
 - Profanity / Racism / Inappropriate Language
 - Nudity / Sexual Content
 - Violence / Abuse-Self
 - Violence / Rape / Abuse-Others
 - Alcohol / Smoking / Drugs
- Warnings are sent to the student on the 1st & 2nd violations; Accounts are suspended on the 3rd violation
- LESSON: If you want to talk about this stuff, do it on your own email, not your school account

HMS GAGGLE (cont.):

- Additional information:
 - When violations occur, a conversation will take place between the student and the administration and/or school counselor
 - If your account gets shut down because of
 3 violations, it will be suspended for 3-4
 weeks
 - Parents may request to have information from Gaggle about their students' accounts sent to them via email from the office
 - Law enforcement may request records from Gaggle upon serious violations

- What to do if . . . (for students)
- I have a problem with my laptop?
- Tell your teacher -> take it to the help desk in the GHS Media Center (it might be a quick fix or it might be something that needs more intensive tech help)
- Other students are sending me inappropriate messages or materials?
- Tell your teacher -> take a screenshot of it, come to the office for help
- I get "gaggled"?
- After the 3rd Offense, your Google services will be suspended
- I lose my information?
- See Ms. Harmsen in Room 75 and always back up your stuff!
