




Hi everyone,

The Grinnell Middle School Tiger Club needs your help! The school district budget rules have changed. Money in the school's activities fund can no longer be used to pay for the speakers and special events that our students enjoy during the school day. Money from the activities fund can only be used for activities that take place outside of school hours. This means the money for events during the school day has to come from another part of the budget like maybe the fund that pays for textbooks or classroom supplies OR from an outside source. That is where the Tiger Club comes to the rescue.

Since we need to pull in some money pretty quickly, we have joined up with Connected (the Grinnell Elementary School PTO) to extend a sale they had earlier this year to the middle school. Here's what we have to offer:

We are selling pizza and doughnut cards from Casey's General Store. These are punch cards that you can use 10 times each. They are good at ANY Casey's store anywhere and have no expiration date. The doughnut card entitles you to half price doughnuts by the dozen (Buy 6 doughnuts and get 6 more free) and the pizza card gives you a free medium, single topping pizza every time you buy a large specialty pizza. You can purchase the cards in the office at Grinnell Middle School or you can simply fill out the form and send money to the school with your child. The Pizza cards cost \$15 each and the doughnut cards cost \$10 each. Make checks payable to the Tiger Club.



P.S. To save you time, here's the math on this. A medium single topping pizza costs \$10.49. If you use all 10 punches, you are getting \$104.90 worth of pizzas for only \$15! Likewise, the doughnut card saves you \$3.99 every time you use it. If you use all 10 punches, that's \$39.90 worth of doughnuts for only \$10. And, you gain the satisfaction of helping support your child's school. That's not too shabby!
