The Grinnell Sports Camp is an opportunity for boys and girls in Poweshiek County to receive sports instruction in a noncompetitive and safe environment under the guidance of members of the Grinnell College coaching staff. Emphasis is placed on enjoyment and sportsmanship, while learning the fundamentals of basketball, baseball, and soccer through games and activities.

The Program:

Each week the camp will focus on a different sport. Players will learn fundamentals and participate in drills to improve their individual skills and their teamwork. The focus will be on fun and enjoyment, as well as athletic development. A recreational swim in Grinnell College's Russell K. Osgood Pool will be incorporated into daily activities.

General Information:

Registration will take place on a first-come, first-served basis. Enrollment may be limited to ensure safety and appropriate coach/child ratio. Participants will meet at the Grinnell College Bear Recreation and Athletic Center on the north side of 10th Avenue. Campers should wear shorts, T-shirts, and appropriate footwear. A bathing suit and towel will also be needed for the recreational swim. Participants in baseball should bring a glove, if available. Participants in soccer should wear shin guards. All other equipment will be provided by the camp staff. Each camper will receive a T-shirt.
