Recommended Sequence	Seminar Meeting
Objective(s) / Learning Target(s):	1. Seminar leaders and students will have the opportunity to reconnect after winter break with some simple conversation starters.
Materials Needed:	Materials 1. None (LCD Projector for Seminar Leader)
Suggested Process:	1. Welcome students and ask for any good news they might have to share (something good that's happened to them since the last time you've been together). 2. Today's activity is simply to reconnect and to get everyone talking again. Jump in and respond to any of these questions. TRY TO practice . . . 1) respectfully listening to others 2) sharing your thoughts and responses 3) refraining from judging anyone's responses Feel free to share your responses to these as well, especially if your kids want to know your thoughts! 1) If you didn't sleep, what would you do with your extra time? 2) What job would you be terrible at? 3) What is the most annoying habit other people have? 4) What age do you wish you could permanently be? 5) What are you interested in that most people haven't heard of? 6) What was the last thing you purchased? 7) Are you a spender or a saver? 8) What type of little kid were you? (e.g. spoiled, rebellious, quiet, obnoxious, well-behaved . . .) 9) What is something that you'll never do again? 10) What did you want to be when you were a little kid? 11) What's the best piece of advice that you ever received? 12) What are you most scared of? 13) If you could have any superpower, what would it be? 14) What website do you visit most often? 15) What's your favorite movie of all time? 16) What's your biggest regret? 17) What is something that a lot of people are obsessed with but you don't get the point of? 18) If you could live anywhere in the world, where would it be? 19) Do you believe that people are inherently good? 20) What would you do if you only had a week left to live?
