| <p>Objective(s) / Learning Target(s):</p> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students will understand what to do in the case of an emergency situation while at school. 2. Staff will review the procedures for: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Tornado Drill, Fire Drill, & Intruder/Lockdown Drill 3. Staff and Students will practice all of the drills |

| <p>Suggested Process:</p> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Welcome students to Seminar and let them know that we are taking a break from the normal Seminar activities to cover some important information about our emergency procedures here at GHS. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Discussion questions to review first: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Why do we need to do this? * Why is it important to take these seriously? 2. Review with them the emergency information that posted on their classroom walls next to the door (5 minutes). <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) In the event of a fire or bomb threat – we would exit the building _____ <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Remind students that in the case of a fire, they would stay with their groups and get as far away from the building and to their designated area outside of the school b) In the event of a tornado – we would go to _____ c) In the event of an intruder in the building, we would lockdown inside the classroom, lights off, and be out of sight and away from the door. 3. Then inform students that they are going to practice the drills: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Tornado drill – please wait for the “high pitched whoop, whoop” sound over the intercom and go to your designated area; “All clear” will be given and you may return to your room. b. Fire drill – take students out the nearest door and gather away from the building. c. Intruder drill – WE ARE JUST DOING THE LOCKDOWN drill – we are not evacuating based on the intruder location. <p><i>* Remember, stay calm, this is only a drill. (But take it seriously so you know what’s happening in the case that it’s the real thing . . .)</i></p> |
