<p>Objective(s) / Learning Target(s):</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Identify skills they'd like to use in their future careers. ● Explore different ways they can get work experience now ● Identify several ways to get experience while still in school ● Assess which type of experience is best suited for their career interests and goals. ● Generate a list of school offerings, including courses or specialized programs, that provide an opportunity to gain work-related experience.
<p>Materials Needed:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Projector ● Xello Powerpoint
<p>Suggested Process:</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ask students what they learned their 1st Trimester of high school? 2. Asking students what are their career goals, do these goals involve college, tech trades, diplomas or something else? 3. Walk students through the powerpoint presentation for direction on how to work Xello. Students can also follow the written directions on this document. 4. Walk around and look at the matches that students get, are they a good match why or why not. 5. Talk with students about how their core tasks and workplace description align with the students interests and values. 6. After everyone has saved at least 3 careers, ask them to discuss in small groups or as a group these questions. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Why do you think these are the top identified skills? ● Which of your skills appeared in your career exploration? ● How do they relate to tasks within that career?
