<p>Objective(s) / Learning Target(s):</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● How can I get work-related experiences while I am still in school? ● What classes do I need in order to get the experience I want?
<p>Materials Needed:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Attendance in classroom and then students report to Auditorium with computers. ● Computer/ Infinite Campus Log In
<p>Suggested Process:</p>	<p>1. Before you start the activity, ask your students to share any pieces of good news they have (something good that’s happened to them since your last meeting – from school, personal lives, extra-curriculars, etc.). Not everyone has to share, but give kids a chance to do this. You can model this by sharing a piece of good news that you have.</p> <p>2. Introduce students to the idea of work related opportunities.</p> <p>What skills did they learn about themselves last time that they need to explore or work on to get into a field they are interested in?</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Take students to the auditorium at this time - have them bring their laptops with them!</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Please sit with your Seminar groups – not in the back or on the side, please.</i></p> <p><u>Counselors will . . .</u></p> <p>3. Introduce speaker and her/his role in our school, tying it to work related opportunities.</p> <p>4.
