

Grade Level: 9th	
Recommended Sequence	Seminar Meeting
Objective(s) / Learning Target(s):	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students will start their GHS Seminar Portfolios 2. Students will take a “personality test” and reflect on the results of their test.
Materials Needed:	Materials <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Overhead projector/screen (seminar leader) 2. Laptop computers (students)
Suggested Process:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Share any good news that you or students have 2. Inform students about the purpose of Seminar and that successful completion of Seminar activities will give them a credit needed for Graduation 3. Create a “Google Folder” in Google Drive 4. Take the 3Cubes Personality Test
Discussion Questions:	<p>Discussion:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Before you start the activity, ask your students to share any pieces of good news they have (something good that’s happened to them since your last meeting – from school, personal lives, extra-curriculars, etc.). Not everyone has to share, but give kids a chance to do this. You can model this by sharing a piece of good news that you have. 2. Once this is completed, inform your 9th grade students that Seminar is a credited activity – meaning, that if they participate and complete the activities and create a ‘portfolio’ of them, they’ll receive a <u>required</u> credit for Graduation. 3. First thing today: You ALL need to create a Google Folder in Drive. Once you create it, simply name your folder YOUR NAME – Last name then first (ex. Smith, John). 4. 5. Once you have that done, open up a new tab in your browser and go to <https://tinyurl.com/y2hl65lw> (you could also copy and paste the link and send this to your students).

You should come to a page that looks like this:

6. You are going to take a personality test (and I'll give you fair warning, it's different – but pay attention and answer the questions thoughtfully).

7. Click "Take the Test"

8. Once you have answered the 25 questions, it will ask you to "Sign-Up" by entering your name and email address. This doesn't cost anything and you can skip the age, gender, and status dropdowns.

- In the next page, just click on "View My Reports" and on the next page click on "View Report."
- Read your report
 - Does anything surprise you about it?
 - Did you feel like it was accurate? Why or why not?
 - What about it was accurate? What about it was not?
 - Were there any findings that you want to stay the same about yourself? Were there any findings that you want to change?

9. Take a minute to copy and paste the full report from the 3SmartCubes webpage, onto the document you opened in your Google Folder. You can title the document "9th Grade Personality Test"

10. Congratulations – you have your first "Graduation Portfolio" assignment done!

11. Remind students that next week (Thursday or Friday), they will report to Seminar but it will be an MTSS day which means that teachers may be requesting them to come to their rooms for extra help, test retakes, etc.
