Create a “Google Folder” in Google Drive</li> <li>4. Take the Crystal Knows Personality Test</li> </ol>   |
| <b>Discussion Questions:</b>              | <p><b>Discussion:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Before you start the activity, ask your students to share any pieces of good news they have (something good that’s happened to them since your last meeting – from school, personal lives, extra-curriculars, etc.). Not everyone has to share, but give kids a chance to do this. You can model this by sharing a piece of good news that you have.</li> <li>2. Once this is completed, inform your 9<sup>th</sup> grade students that Seminar will become credited activity – meaning, that if they participate and complete the activities and create a ‘portfolio’ of them, they’ll receive a <u>required</u> credit for Graduation.</li> <li>3. First thing today: You ALL need to create a Google Folder in Drive. Once you create it, simply name your folder YOUR NAME – Last name then first (ex. Smith, John).</li> <li>4. Once you’re in your folder, click on the NEW button and scroll down to “Google Docs” -&gt; “Blank Document”</li> </ol> <div data-bbox="565 1499 974 1671" data-label="Image"> </div> <div data-bbox="557 1709 1533 1818" data-label="Image"> </div> <p>(Seriously, you should all be able to do this by now)</p> |

5. Once you have that done, open up a new tab in your browser and go to <https://www.crystalknows.com/personality-test>

(you could also copy and paste the link and send this to your students).

You should come to a page that looks like this:

6. You are going to take a personality test (and I'll give you fair warning, it's different you may not like the choices but choose 1 that is most like you and 1 that is least like you - pay attention and answer the questions thoughtfully).

8. Once you have answered the questions, it will ask you take you to your results ("Disc Test" & Type).

- In the next page, just click on "Sign up For a Free Account" and after you've entered your email & password info, it will ask you what your gender, location, and role are (Select Student) as your role and don't worry about entering in a job type.
- Once you've read your reports and clicked through the "Next Boxes" go to "Profile" at the top of the page.

#### Discussion

- Read your report
  - Does anything surprise you about it?
  - Did you feel like it was accurate? Why or why not?
  - Do the 3 words used to describe you sound accurate?
  - What about it was accurate? What about it was not?
  - Were there any findings that you want to stay the same about yourself? Were there any findings that you want to change?
  - What do others need to know about you according to this?

9. Take a minute to copy and paste the full report from the crystalknows webpage, onto the document you opened in your Google Folder. You can title the document "9<sup>th</sup> Grade Personality Test"
